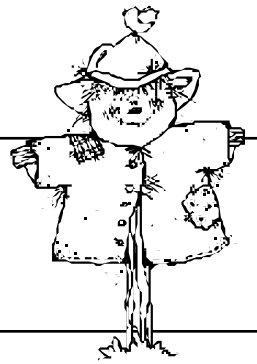

### **Other Important Reminders & Notes:**

- **Lakeview Book Fair:** Nov. 18-21 our school will be hosting a Book Fair to raise money for books for our school. There will be no Library classes that week. Our Kindergarten AM & PM class will be given a special day & time on Monday, Nov. 18 to visit the Library to shop at the Book Fair - dates and times will be given when confirmed.
