Feb. 27 (Thurs.) - Hot Lunch: Domino's Pizza

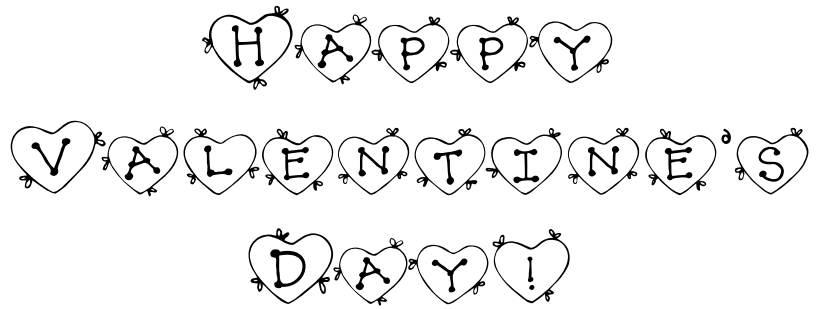
